The \$795 award covers the entire cost of the five day program hosted by The Fly Shop in Redding, Ca. This includes accommodations, meals, plus use of their fly fishing equipment. This is the premier fly fishing school in the Western United States. Fly Fishers for Conservation has reserved two (2) spots in the June 27th- July 1st FishCamp session. The participant awarded the scholarships may also be asked to attend an FFFC general meeting to give a short presentation about their experience at FishCamp.
